PHILOSOPHY:

The Poland School Committee is a five (5) member committee whose charge is to administer the Poland School Department in accordance with Poland School Committee policy.

The members of the Poland School Committee are the citizens' representatives.

POLICY:

It is the policy of the Poland School Committee that a person is legally qualified to serve on the Poland School Committee if he or she is a citizen of the United States, a resident of the State of Maine and Town of Poland, and a qualified, registered voter in the Town of Poland.

Elections for School Committee shall be non-partisan. Candidates' qualifications, residency requirements and proper procedures shall be in accordance with those that are required of other candidates for municipal offices in the Town of Poland.

No member of the Poland School Committee or spouse shall be a ~~full-time employee~~ employed in the ~~Poland School Department~~ one of the Union #29 school administrative units.

AMPLIFYING INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES:

School Committee members shall meet the basic legal requirements of MRSA Title 20.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:

The authority to monitor implementation of this policy is delegated to the Superintendent of Schools
