SUBJECT: STUDENT PARKING POLICY

JURISDICTION: Poland Regional High School

Rules:

1. All students requesting permission to park vehicles on campus must first apply to the School Resource Officer for a parking permit. When applying for a permit, student must provide: proof of driver's license, proof of insurance and vehicle description – registration, make, model, year, and color.
2. Parking permits for students must be purchased from the school through the School Resource Officer.
3. One parking permit must be purchased for each approved vehicle.
4. The price for each student parking permit is \$1.50 – non-refundable.
5. All student vehicles must remain parked in the Student Parking Lot at all times.
6. By Federal law, all student vehicles brought on campus are subject to searches by School Administration randomly or based upon reasonable suspicion. Keys will be provided to any School Administrator who makes a reasonable request from a student whose vehicle is parked on school property.
7. Traffic laws must be obeyed at all times when driving on school property. The maximum speed limit on school property is 15 MPH at all times. Conditions may dictate a maximum speed of less than 15 MPH.
8. All vehicles are parked on school property at owner's risk.
9. Vehicles parked in other than designated parking areas will be subject to suspension or revocation of parking privileges and/or towing at owner's expense.

Penalties:

1. Violation of parking/driving policy:
First offense: Suspension of parking privileges for one week.
Second offense: Suspension of parking privileges for one month.
Third and subsequent offense: Suspension of parking privilege for remainder of school year.
