Goals:

- To allow students at each elementary school equitable access to participation in a full **instrumental experience** through school in grades 5-6
- To allow students at each elementary school equitable access to participation in a full **choral experience** through school in grades 5-6
- To eliminate a staffing deficit in the RSU 16 music department

## **Expected Benefits:**

- Increase student engagement with school
- Opportunities for highly-engaged students to participate in programs outside of school (district festivals, etc.)
- Alleviated schedule for ESS/MCS teacher to take on Choral music and still maintain contract prep times/manageable teaching load
- Increased participation at the secondary level in instrumental/choral programs
- Community benefits (musical presence at events)

## Consequences of Non-Approval:

- Inability to provide adequate prep time for current ESS/MCS music position
- Potential struggle for retention of music teacher at ESS/MCS with current schedule
- Diminishing numbers of ensemble enrollment at secondary schools
- Later start to instrumental has negative impact on skill development which then impacts students' ability to participate with peers across the state
- Fewer resources with which to put forth public performances (e.g. Graduation band)
- GATE students not receiving adequate contact time
- Continuing to have a music program that can not meet all national/state standards for music

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Resources Required (List and cost of staff, materials, space):

- One FTE music teacher position
- Dedicated space at each elementary school for band rehearsals, pull-out lessons, and general music classes.

All equipment needed is already in possession of RSU16. There would be minimal initial materials cost to reboot the elementary band program.
