

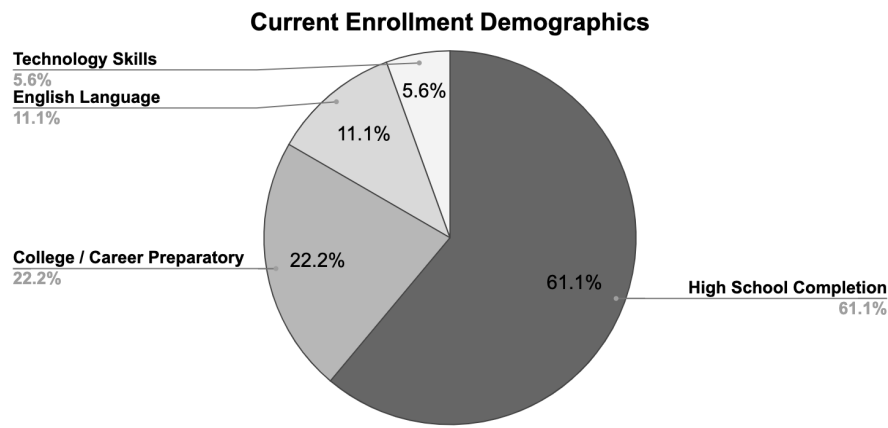
# RSU 16 School Board Administrative Report

## Enrollment

- We have enrolled 34 students to date this school year, which is much higher than last year – and even slightly higher than 2018 and 2019 at this time. Over half are in the 16-20 year old age range. Not all 34 attend regularly, but we are seeing a very high degree of diligence and commitment from those who do. These new and returning learners are participating in classes toward high school completion, college transitions, English language acquisition, computer class and/or workforce exploration.



## Professional Development

Recent professional development activities have included topics such as fostering resilience, student advising and assessment, State Directors' Meeting, Teaching Skills That Matter. We also welcomed our new Hub 6 Aspirations Coordinator who will be onsite at our program on Mondays.

## McKinney Vento Homeless Liaison Report

On October 29th, I attended a regional McKinney Vento team meeting with liaisons from Lewiston, Auburn, Sabattus and Lisbon.

To date this school year, we have identified 6 McKinney Vento youth in our schools – students who lack a FIXED, ADEQUATE and REGULAR nighttime residence.
