

How does an academic student get started with Adult Education?

Registrations are by appointment with our Career Advisor, Suzette, or myself. This 'Intake' interview collects information required by the DOE office of Adult Education. Students are assessed using our required Comprehensive Adult Student Assessment System (CASAS) in both reading and math as well as respond to a writing prompt. We also administer learning style assessments and review any applicable information from prior schools. Combined, these pieces help to inform next steps, goals and individualized instruction over the course of the student's time with us.

How successful is Adult Education at serving RSU 16 students who discontinue their education?

Data maintained since 2011/2012 indicates that 68% of PRHS discontinuing students come to our program at some point. Another 20% attend Adult Education elsewhere. Students who 'attended previously' often return in subsequent months or years and become graduates. We appreciate PRHS Guidance and Administration for their roles in helping us to make these connections!



McKinney Vento Homeless Liaison Report

To date this school year, we have identified **11** McKinney Vento homeless youth in our schools – students who lack a FIXED, ADEQUATE and REGULAR nighttime residence.
