We started the 2022/2023 school year with a 5-week summer session in July and August. A dozen students returned or enrolled with us during that time to work toward academic and career goals.

We re-opened on August 31st for the fall semester and were excited to see ten students during just the first few days. Our schedule for academic programming is Monday through Thursday from 9am – 3pm; and Wednesday evenings from 5:30-8:30pm. We are still looking to fill part-time vacancies for a Literacy Tutor and a Technology Instructor.

Our fall course catalog, featuring over twenty community enrichment classes, will be delivered in mid-September to tri-town mailboxes as well as to several community locations.

21/22 Recap

As shared in our June report, we ended the last school year with 61 student registrations. This was more than the previous year and closer to average. Eighty percent of these students were participating in high school completion, college preparation and career advising, with a majority in the 16-20 year old age range. Others took part in basic literacy and technology programming. In May we celebrated the graduation of 12 students. In addition, we also served 56 residents through various community enrichment classes over the course of the school year. We are hoping to see at least double or triple this number in FY23!

McKinney Vento Homeless Liaison Report

We have designated 5 McKinney Vento youth in our RSU 16 schools since July 1. These are students who lack a FIXED, REGULAR AND ADEQUATE night-time residence.
