Graduation

Preparation is underway for our Adult Education Graduation on Friday, June 9 at 6:30 pm in the Elm Street School gym. Three students have graduated so far, and a few more are close to finishing. We still have 20 students actively working toward High School or HiSET completion; some with aspirations to finish during our summer session or early fall, and others just beginning. Our open entry model allows students to enroll with us at any time during the year, so they don't have to wait for a new session to start before moving forward with their academic goals.


Community classes

The winter/spring community enrichment classes we were able to offer are winding down. We ran 12 of the 15 classes we offered; others were canceled due to low/no enrollment. Babysitting, Zumba and Notary classes were among the most popular. We will be looking ahead to a few classes for summer as well as many fall programs, and we are always open to ideas and suggestions!

We had to postpone our Retail/Customer Service class due to low enrollment. We hope to try offering it again during our 5-week summer session in July and August.

McKinney Vento Homeless Liaison

To date this school year, we have identified 23 McKinney Vento homeless youth in our RSU 16 schools students who lack a FIXED, ADEQUATE and REGULAR nighttime residence.



We have collaborated with other schools or with DHHS on assessment and/or transportation for another 15 students who landed in an RSU 16 town but continue to attend their 'school of origin'.
