- We continue to need Ed Techs throughout the District. We had a new ed tech start at PRHS on May 1<sup>st</sup>, but still need many more, especially at the high school.
- 2023-2024 openings:
  Speech and Language Pathologist at ESS
  FLS Teacher, PRHS
  Special Education Teacher, PRHS
- Update on State DOE Audit: We were able to clear up all but one of our pre-findings, which is good news. We will receive a corrective action plan on June 30<sup>th</sup> with the areas we need to address and correct by April 2024.
- On April 27<sup>th</sup>, several of our FLS students participated in events at the Special Olympics State Swim meet held at Colby College. Our students represented RSU 16 well!
- Last year the DOE allowed special education teachers to work under emergency certification. It has been discovered, however, that Federal laws do not allow <u>special education teachers</u> to work under emergency certification. This will further stress both our District and other Districts in the state. Special Education teachers can work under conditional certification, which requires a Bachelor's degree and nine hours in special education coursework.
