Teaching and Learning

Poland Regional High School's 25th school year started off with a very successful first day for our 9th grade students of the 147 enrolled students, all but three students were in attendance! We are looking forward to working with students and families to maintain high attendance rates all year.

The high school is quite excited to have four exchange students this year. These students from France, Germany, Spain, and Italy will have tremendous learning opportunities with their PRHS classmates and faculty - and we appreciate the chance to learn from them about their home countries.

Staff and Professional Learning

PRHS has six areas of focus for faculty professional learning and collaboration this year:

- 1. The New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) re-accreditation, multi-year process is beginning.
- 2. Further developing our Building Assets/Reducing Risks (BARR) protocols with all faculty.
- 3. Implementing a revised Habits of Work (HOW) rubric to support student learning.
- 4. Reviewing and revising high school course offerings.
- 5. Refreshing Roundtable curriculum.
- 6. Ongoing curriculum work and capturing course and unit information in Atlas.

Principal Erik Anderson and Assistant Principal Kat Meader completed Level 1 training for the Comprehensive School Threat Assessment Guidelines (CSTAG). SRO Berni Westleigh completed all levels of CSTAG including the specialized training for School Resource Officers.
