Programming Updates

We started this school year with a goal to surpass last year's low enrichment participation numbers by two or three times, and we are happy to report that we are on our way to triple. Since July, we have received 136 registrations for various community enrichment classes. In 21/22, as we slowly re-engaged with our community, we served a total of 56 residents through enrichment classes over the course of the whole school year.

Attendance hours in high school completion programming have been consistently higher each month this year in comparison to 21/22 but are not quite back to pre-pandemic levels. Last month's attendance, however, was over twice that of January 2022.

To date this year, we have enrolled 32 students in High School Completion classes. Last year, we enrolled a total of 39.

We recently recognized the completion of our first 'Class of 2023' graduate. When students finish their high school completion program, they sign their name to our ceremonial list of graduates for that year's class. Some students invite guests to come watch. They also have the option to march at our formal cap and gown graduation ceremony in June - held in the Elm Street School gym.

To date this school year, we have identified **18** McKinney Vento homeless youth in our schools – students who lack a FIXED, ADEQUATE and REGULAR nighttime residence.
