Since RSU 16 is a recipient of a federal grant under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) of 1965 it must display, in a public place, the hotline contact information of the US Department of Education Office of the Inspector General (ED OIG) to ensure that any individual who observes, detects, or suspects improper use of taxpayer funds can report such improper use.
